Health

Water And Vector Borne Diseases Leading to Malnutrition Among Children

Expense

Increase in Medical Expense

Only 12% Women Use Sanitary Napkins, as Per an AC Nielsen Report

- Remaining 88 % Resort to Unhygienic Measures
- Poor Menstrual Hygiene and Usage of Dirty Water Directly Linked to Incidence of Cervical Cancer and Reproductive Tract Infections (RTI)

As per a study report, India has one of the highest rate of cervical cancer, ~72,000 women die every year

Low Usage of Condoms in India

(specially in rural areas)

- **2.1 million** Indians Infected with Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD), Particularly **HIV-AIDS**
- India to be Most Populous Nation by 2030



Need for Toilets in Circulating Areas of Railway Stations

- >>> Lack of Proper Sanitation Facilities in and around Stations Premises for
 - People Accompanying Passengers
 - Local Hawkers
 - Vendors
 - Auto/Taxi Drivers
 - Nearby Community
- >> Open Areas under/near Station Premises being used for Urination/defecation Creating Unhygienic Surroundings that Poses a Severe Public Health Hazard
- >>> Lack of Separate Toilets for Men, Women and Divyangjans around Station Premises

Swachh Station, Swachh Bharat

Toilet Units for Men, Women and Divyangjans:

- Prefab Toilets to be Installed in Circulating
 Areas of ~8700 Railway Stations
- Estimated Cost ₹ 22 30 lakhs per unit (for Men, Women and Divyangjans) Including Installation and Maintenance for One Year

*Cost Varies Depending upon the use of Solar Pump, Water and Septic Tank

Each Toilet Unit will Provide for:

- → 4 urinals, 3 WC and 2 wash basins for Male,
 3 WC and 2 wash basins for Female & 1 WC
 and 1 wash basin for 'Divyangjan'
- ► Janitor room, Condom Vending Machines, Sanitary Napkin Dispenser & Incinerator


- ▶ Free Access to all will lead to Greater Usage And Cleaner Station Premises
- Increase In Menstrual Hygiene among
 Women due to Access and Availability of Low Cost Sanitary Pads
- Decrease In Incidences of Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) along with Control of Population due to Usage of Contraceptives
